

Why do we recommend removing the flowers and fruit for the first 2 years?

For the overall health of the citrus tree and your family, remove the fruits and flowers for the first two years.

THE LAW AND SYSTEMIC PESTICIDES

The Texas Department of Agriculture mandates the spraying of *all citrus trees in the state of Texas* with Neonicotinoids to combat the serious insect spreading disease “Citrus Greening Disease”.

1. FOR THE HEALTH OF THE PLANT:

- Supporting vigorous roots and strong limbs by redirecting energy away from the flowers and fruit.
- Establishing a larger sturdier plant before allowing it to bear all the weight of your amazing harvest!

2. FOR THE HEALTH OF YOUR FAMILY & ENVIRONMENT:

- After two years the Neonics should not be present and if cared for organically will now produce organic fruits.
- The bees and other pollinators will not come into contact with the contaminated flowers.
